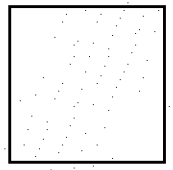

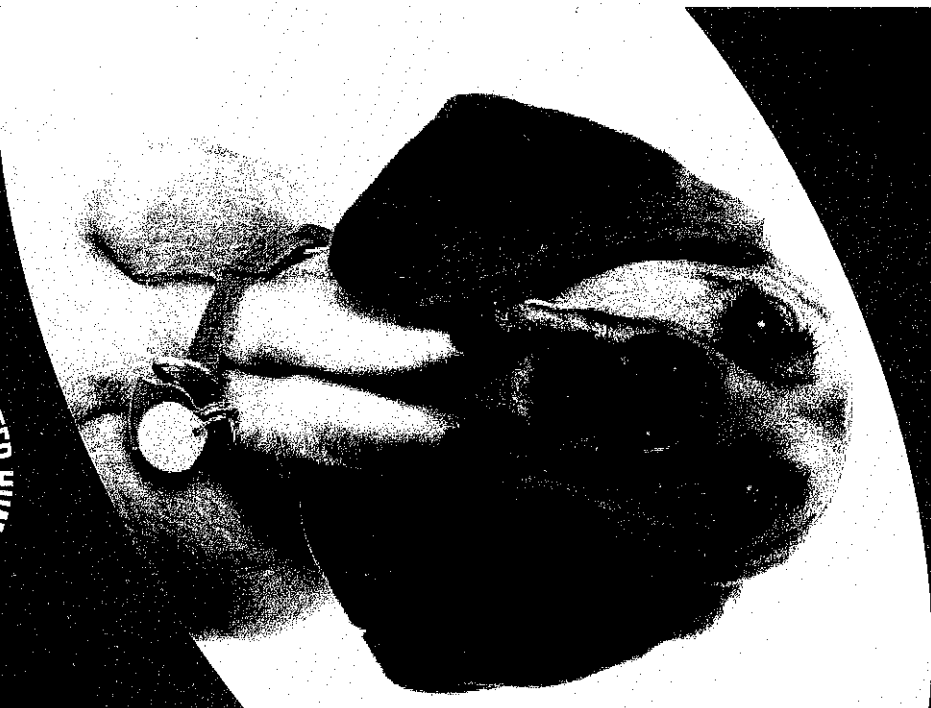

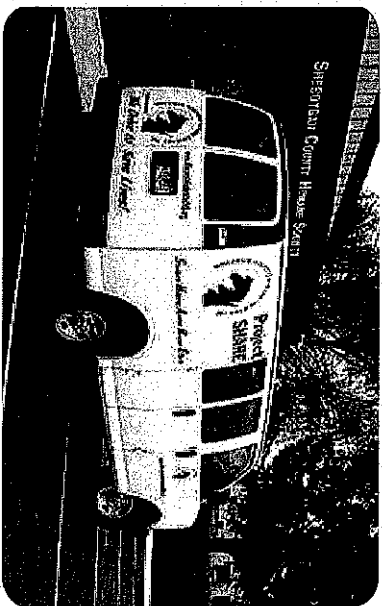


A Proud History
